A potential solution will be tried starting Thursday - see details below. Keep in mind it may not be what you want, what you suggested, or even what will work, but it's a worthwhile attempt to speed the playing rotation and wait time. Play is Monday through Saturday at 8:30 a.m. and Tuesdays and Thursdays at 6:00 p.m. (NOTE NEW TIME). Those evenings are ladder play; there should be a minimum of eight players but generally the ladder is close to full each night.

New Player Rotation Starting Thursday

We will be trialing a whiteboard rotation system. In a nutshell, a player will write their name in a box on the whiteboard using a colored marker corresponding to their level - Social (up to 3.0), Intermediate (3.0-3.5), and Advanced (3.5 and above). Once a box is filled with four names of the same color, those players will go out to the next available court.

This system will replace the paddle rack and the need to assign courts by level. This flexibility will allow court usage to be allocated more proportionally by the level of players showing up on any given day and also to allow for more levels of play.

It may seem confusing at first, but there will be players who have used this system on site to help.

It may need some tweaking along the way so we ask for smiles, patience, and constructive comments only please.
